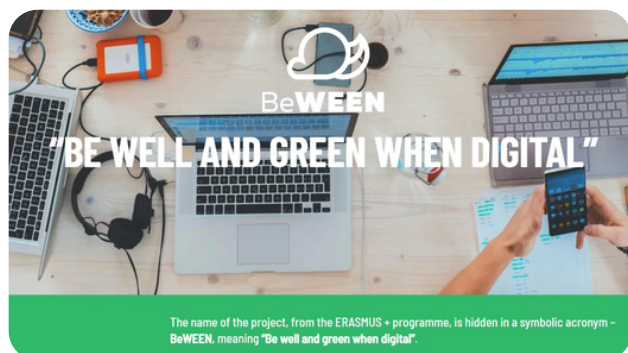


BE WELL AND GREEN WHEN DIGITAL

Curriculum

- The **curriculum** was developed for the training course BeWEEN, which is primarily designed for pre-service and in-service high school teachers who would like to acquire **digital competencies** related to **protecting health and well-being** as well as **protecting the environment** while using digital technologies.
- Since there are no specific prerequisites for this course, in addition to high school teachers, the course could also be used by all others interested in acquiring digital competencies related to protecting health, well-being, and the environment. The leading organisation of this project result is the Centre of technical culture – Rijeka.
- Learning management system is developed which will host our training course – Moodle.



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About the project

The name of the project, from the **ERASMUS +** programme, is hidden in a symbolic acronym – BeWEEN, meaning **“Be well and green when digital”**. The project is of action type **KA220-SCH-Cooperation partnerships in schools**, taking place in the school education field .

- **Impact on EU policies concerning the safe and responsible use of digital technology.**

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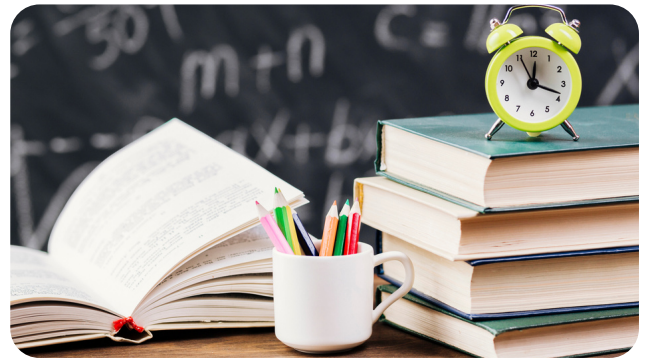
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Training materials

- When it comes to research, partners from Greece – National technical university of Athens and Austria, University of Vienna prepared a research framework and a detailed work plan for development of the course material and training.

- We are currently pilot testing the materials and making adjustments with gathered teachers.

How we gathered the teachers?

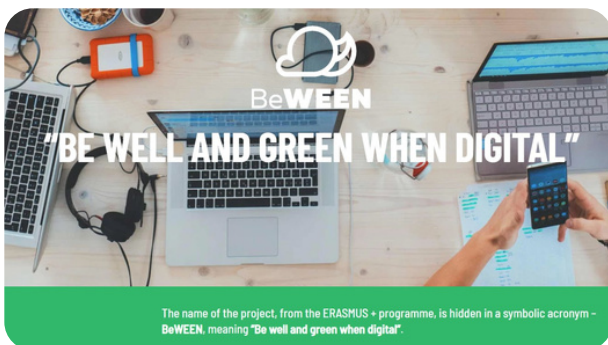
